~ What's Happening at West Swamp ~

A brief **congregational meeting** will be Sunday, July 4, following the worship service, to seek approval for an increase to the 2021 budget line item for Outside Church Painting. The budget, as approved in January, for this line item is \$5,000. The Stewardship Committee is proposing an increase to \$9,500.

MCC School Kits: Since MCC has requested school kits by the end of July, Mission Commission is starting our collection time a little earlier than usual. You can start dropping off items or complete kits now. Deadline for donations is July 25. Look in the July newsletter for a list of items needed.

Care & Share Service Evening: The Mission Commission invites you to volunteer for an evening at Care & Share on Thursday, July 15 from 5:30-8 pm. A variety of tasks are available: at the clothing store—quality control, price tagging and stocking; at the furniture store, processing electronics, simple sorting, testing, etc. If there is interest, light cleaning of artwork and furniture is needed too. C&S will have paid staff in both departments to guide and be resources. Their COVID protocol (as of now) is consistent with CDC guidelines—fully vaccinated people are not required to wear masks; they fully sterilize the facilities regularly. MCC thrift stores are a huge source of funds for MCC and there is a tremendous need for volunteers. Look for a sign up sheet next week.
