Thanks to the cemetery committee, Elaine Propst, the Stewardship Committee and the Ministry Team for working together to update the cemetery rules and regulations. There were several questions after the meeting and we want to clarify the answers.

- 1. If you already have a reserved plot there is NOTHING you need to do. There is NO further cost for the plot.
- If you are an Active Member of the church you are entitled to a free plot in the cemetery. This is in effect until 12/31/2023. Beginning 1/1/2024 Active Members will be charged \$500 and Non-Members \$1500 to reserve a plot

Please note that each plot can include: One casket OR one casket and one cremation urn OR 2 cremation urns.
