1. If you already have a reserved plot there is NOTHING you need to do. There is NO further cost for the plot.
2. If you are an Active Member of the church you are entitled to a free plot in the cemetery. This is in effect until 12/31/2023. Beginning 1/1/2024 Active Members will be charged \$500 and Non-Members \$1500 to reserve a plot

Please note that each plot can include: One casket OR one casket and one cremation urn OR 2 cremation urns.
