

## ~ What's Happening in the Community ~

All Mosaic congregations are invited to pray for the leaders of Shores of Hope, a community of Russian speakers in West Palm Beach, Florida. Shores of Hope's current mission is to accompany and minister to Ukrainian and Russian refugees in the area, as well as other Russian speakers who grew up in the USSR. Part of their plan is to help their community to develop life skills that will help them thrive in the US. Its leaders also ask for prayer obtaining work authorization, which will allow certain processes to move more quickly.

MCC will operate its mobile meat canner at the MCC Material Resource Center in Souderton from March 25-27 to process 24,000 pounds of pork to send to Cuba and Ukraine. 100 volunteers are required daily, working a two to six-hour shift (6AM-7PM) to fill and label cans and prepare boxes. Refreshments provided. Tax-deductible donations may be made payable to "MCC Canner Project" and mailed to MCC Material Resource Center, 737 Hagey Center Drive, Unit C, Souderton, PA 18964.
