





~ <u>What's Happening at West Swamp</u>~

During the summer months as many church activities take a break, why not use the extra time to do some old-fashioned visiting to members who can't get around much?

Food always brings people together. Consider signing up to host a **Fellowship Time** after a Sunday service. Lots of open slots!

The Mission Commission will be collecting items for MCC school kits in August, but you might want to start shopping now. Staples currently has great prices on many school supplies needed for the kits. Here's what goes in a kit:

- 4 spiral or perforated-page notebooks (140 pages each)
- 8 new **unsharpened** pencils
- 1 ruler (flat, good quality; must indicate 30 cm, inch markings optional)
- 12 colored pencils (in packaging)
- 1 large eraser
- 4 new black or blue ballpoint pens
- 1 small all-metal pencil sharpener (one or two holes)*

School kits are packed in a very specific way. If you want to pack bags, please be sure to watch the video on the MCC School Kit webpage. Otherwise, please just bring your items to church where they will get packed correctly. *We have about 60 metal sharpeners left from last year, ready to go in kits. All Mosaic congregations are invited to pray for Deep Run East (Perkasie, PA) as they host a candidating weekend this week and consider their candidate for a lead pastor.

Right Relationship Training: All are welcome to join the southeastern PA "Friends of the Delaware Tribe" and the Mennonite Coalition to Dismantle the Doctrine of Discovery for an interactive training that will help us be better allies to our indigenous neighbors, through cross-cultural servant-based relationship building and Christian solidarity.
