Cover art: Jonah being swallowed by the fish, from the Kennicott Bible, an illuminated manuscript copy of the Hebrew Bible, copied in the city of A Conuña in 1476 by the calligrapher Moses ibn Zabarah and illuminated by Joseph ibn Hayyim. It is considered by some to be the most important religious manuscript of medieval Galicia and one of the most exquisite illuminated manuscripts in Hebrew.


