Cover Art: *Lakota Trinity*, by the late artist Father John Giuliani, a Catholic priest who was dedicated to creating Catholic iconography that celebrates the lives and cultures of Native Americans. It was painted for the Lakota community at the St. Francis Mission on the Rosebud Reservation.

The Trinity is central to Christian revelation in which God the Father gives the Son to the world as a love offering, confirmed and kept alive in the spirit of their mutual love and unity. In this image, the great **Father**—Wakan Tanka—appears with a full headdress of eagle feathers in a halo of light. His open hands deliver the **Son**, a victorious Sioux warrior whose raised arms and open hands reflect a similar gesture of self-giving. He wears a richly decorated buckskin war shirt—heavily fringed, beaded and painted with the four color circle of the universe as its breast plate. The eagle represents the **Holy Spirit** and completes the spiral of trinitarian love and unity.

Father Giuliani said, "In my work I truy to celebrate a union of a common spiritual understanding to show how a single mystery can be approached through diverse cultures."
